## 1) Supplies Checklist

Category	Item	Check
Colored pencils	24–36 colors (perfect to start)	<input type="checkbox"/>
Paper	Thicker coloring paper (recommended)	<input type="checkbox"/>
Sharpen	Pencil sharpener	<input type="checkbox"/>
Erase	Kneaded eraser / eraser	<input type="checkbox"/>
Test	Scrap paper for swatches	<input type="checkbox"/>
Hold	Masking tape or clips	<input type="checkbox"/>
Underlay	Writing board (reduces streaks)	<input type="checkbox"/>
Finish (optional)	White pencil / colorless blender	<input type="checkbox"/>
Accent (optional)	Gel pen (white/gold)	<input type="checkbox"/>

Tip: Don't press hard. Keep strokes consistent (or use small circles) and layer lightly.
